| <i>First Produced by Stanislao Cobianchi in 1885. Named to celebrate the marriage of Crown Prince Victor Emmanuel to Princess Even of Montenegro</i> | |
| Averna Amaro | 11 |
| <i>Named after it's inventor, Salvatore Averna who invented the recipe in 1868</i> | |
| Fernet Branca Amaro | 10 |
| <i>Formulated in Milan by a self taught herbalist. Marketed as a pick me up and cure for fever</i> | |
| Amaro Rucolino | 11 |
| <i>Rucolino is derived from rucola, meaning arugula, an aromatic and peppery salad green that grows on the enchanting island of Ischia in the gulf of Naples</i> | |
| Cynar | 10 |
| <i>Enriched by an infusion of over 13 different herbs and plants. The name comes from cynar scolymus, the botanical name for artichoke</i> | |
| Liquore Strega | 10 |
| <i>Italian for witch. Yellow digestif made with over 70 botanicals</i> | |
| Ulrich Amaro | 10 |
| <i>First made in 1854 from a recipe created by botanist Dr Domenico Ulrich</i> | |
| Vecchio Amaro Del Capo | 11 |
| <i>A mix of twenty-nine herbs, flowers, fruits and roots local to Calabria</i> | |
| Meletti Amaro | 9 |
| <i>Produced by a family owned company in Le Marche in the centre of Italy</i> | |
| Zucca Rabarbaro | 9 |
| <i>Made from an infusion of rhubarb rootstocks and other herbs</i> | |
